Safety Guide

- ♥ Staff will wipe down touch points before and after each session
- ♥ Children will be asked to wash their hands on arrival
- ♥ Hand gel, tissues and antibacterial wipes will be available to staff & children
- ♥ Resources will not be shared
- ♥ Drama spaces will be marked out to create bubbles in line with the school's procedures
- ♥ Sessions will be designed adhering to social distancing procedures
- ♥ Sessions will still be fun, engaging, active and creative
- ♥ The drama space will be ventilated at all times
